This certifies that the source described has been demonstrated to meet the regulatory requirements for special form radioactive material as prescribed in the regulations of the International Atomic Energy Agency¹ and the United States of America² for the transport of radioactive material.

1. Source Identification - QSA Global, Inc. Model X1290 (Manufactured on or after November 22, 1995).
2. Source Description - Cylindrical single encapsulation made of stainless steel and tungsten inert gas or laser seal welded. Approximate exterior dimensions are 22.9 mm (0.9 in.) in diameter and 96.5 mm (3.8 in.) in length. Minimum wall thickness is 1.0 mm (0.04 in.). Construction shall be in accordance with attached AEA Technology QSA Inc. Drawing No. RBA62954, Rev. A.
3. Radioactive Contents - No more than 740.0 GBq (20.0 Ci) of Americium-241. The Am-241 is in the form of an oxide mixed with a beryllium powder that is then pressed into a pellet.
4. Management System Activities - Records of Management System activities required by Paragraph 306 of the IAEA regulations shall be maintained and made available to the authorized officials for at least three years after the last shipment authorized by this certificate. Consignors in the United States exporting shipments under this certificate shall satisfy the requirements of Subpart H of 10 CFR 71.
5. Expiration Date - This certificate expires on December 31, 2028. Previous editions which have not reached their expiration date may continue to be used.

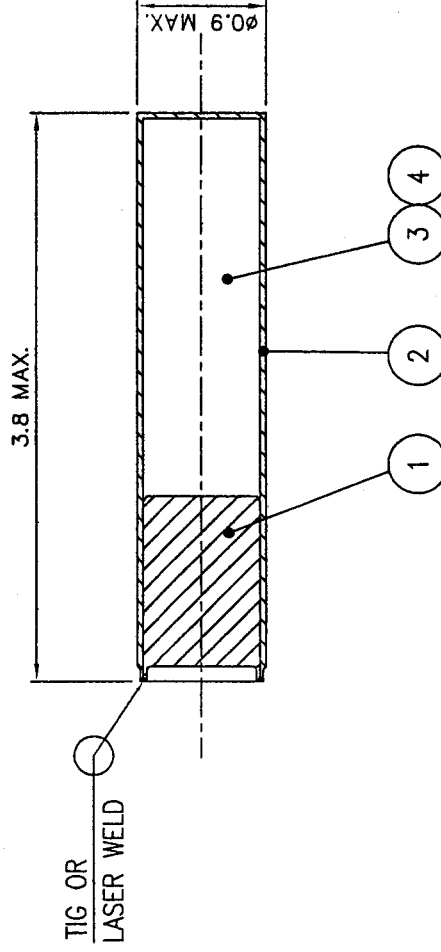
