This certifies that the source described has been demonstrated to meet the regulatory requirements for special form radioactive material as prescribed in the regulations of the International Atomic Energy Agency¹ and the United States of America² for the transport of radioactive material.

1. Source Identification - Eckert & Ziegler Isotope Products Model X131/4.
2. Source Description - Cylindrical single encapsulation made of monel, beryllium, and stainless steel that is brazed on one end and tungsten inert gas, electron beam, or laser welded (fusion welded) on the other end. Approximate outer dimensions are 10.9 mm (0.43 in.) in diameter and 5.2 mm (0.2 in.) in length. Minimum wall thickness is 0.95 mm (0.004 in.). Construction shall be in accordance with attached Eckert & Ziegler Isotope Products Drawing No. RBA61927, Rev. A.
3. Radioactive Contents - No more than 11.1 GBq (300 mCi) of an actinide (isotopes of Ac, Th, Pa, Np, U, Pu, Am, and Cm only). The actinides are in the form of an oxide or an oxide incorporated into a ceramic matrix.
4. Management System Activities - Records of Management System activities required by Paragraph 306 of the IAEA regulations shall be maintained and made available to the authorized officials for at least three years after the last shipment authorized by this certificate. Consignors in the United States exporting shipments under this certificate shall satisfy the requirements of Subpart H of 10 CFR 71.

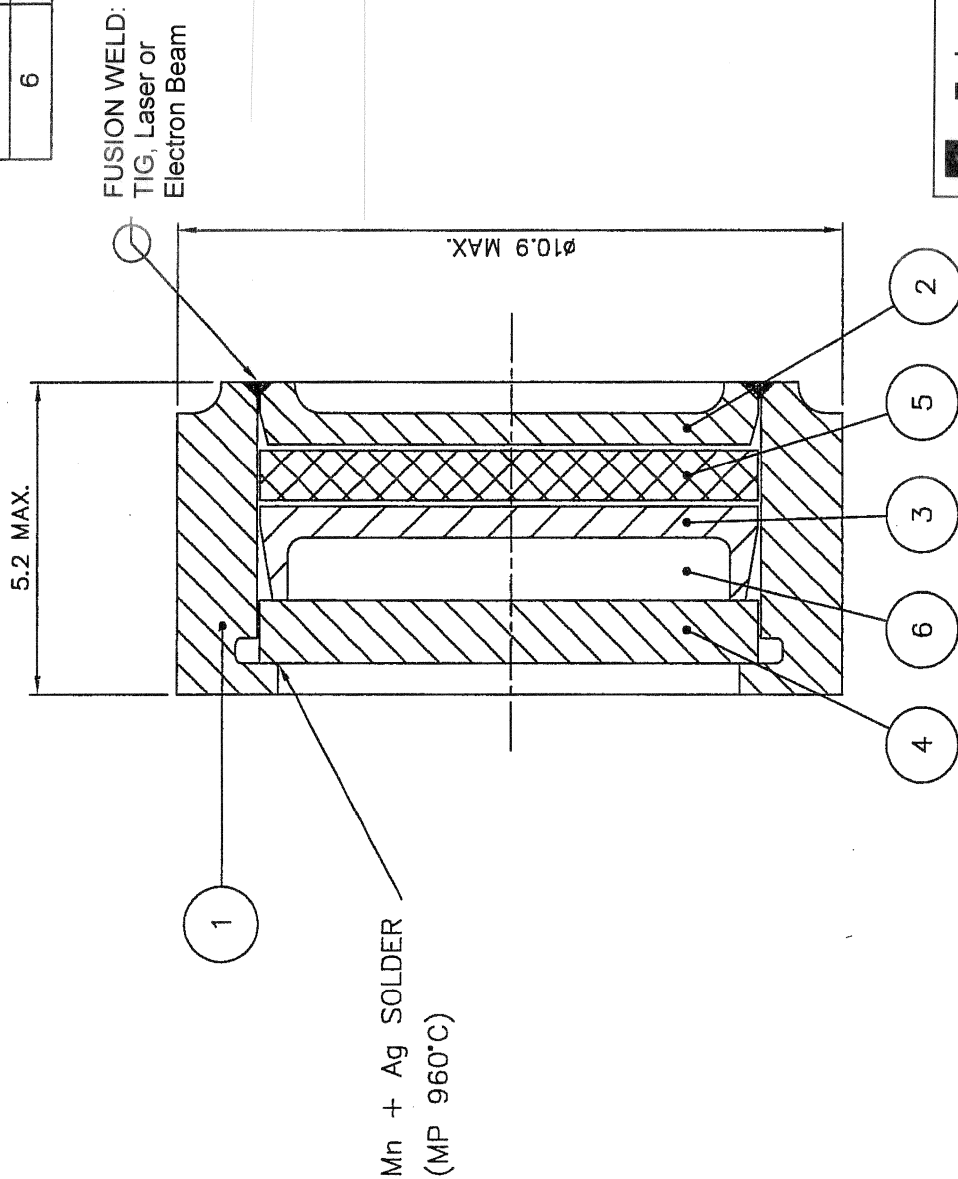
