This Safety Evaluation Report (SER) documents the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Packaging Certification Program (PCP) technical review of the application submitted by the *EnergySolutions* requesting renewal to DOE Certificate of Compliance (CoC) Number 9204.

Summary

By letter dated August 31, 2015,^[1] *EnergySolutions* requested renewal of CoC Number 9204 for the Model 10-160B package. *EnergySolutions* did not request any changes to the package design, or operating procedure, acceptance tests and maintenance program of the package.

Evaluation

By letter dated August 31, 2015, *EnergySolutions* requested renewal of CoC Number 9204 for the Model 10-160B package. PCP staff reviewed the package application dated January 2011, as supplemented, in support of the renewal request and determined that the documentation was available and complete.

Conditions

Condition No. 5(d)(8) was revised to “Revision 8 of this CoC may be used until May 31, 2017.”

Section 5(e)(6) was added to include the request for renewal letter, *EnergySolutions* letter dated August 31, 2015

Conclusion

Based on the statements and representations in the renewal request, PCP staff finds the package meets the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
