Dear Registerer User:

Enclosed is IAEA Certificate of Competent Authority USA/0411/AF, Revision 0, which authorizes the use of 14 listed packagings for the transportation of "heels" of uranium hexafluoride. This package certificate replaces in its entirety IAEA Certificate USA/6273/AF which endorsed the Department of Energy (DOE) Certificates of Approval USA/6273-5 thru 48/AF. All companies or organizations previously registered for USA/6273/AF are hereby registered for USA/0411/AF.

For domestic transport, the regulations regarding the packages indicated in this certificate are found in the Department of Transportation's Regulations in Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 173.417. Because these packages are already authorized by the DOT regulations, the DOE has chosen to retire the DOE Certificates of Approval USA/6273-5 thru 48/AF.

This certificate is issued only to authorize transport from point of entry to final destination within the United States and from point of origin in the United States to point of exit. All domestic shipments with these packagings must be made in accordance with Title 49.
